## **MAJOLICA**

## RICKERSON CATALOGUE - PRICE LIST 1973

Prices listed — for good condition. The listed designs are not complete, but give prices on a sufficient number of pieces so as to give the dealer and collector basic values.

The value of antique or old pottery varies very considerably with condition - a perfect mint condition with excellent lustre might be valued at \$100, whereas a piece that is cracked, chipped or with worn glaze might only bring \$10 to \$20. It is up to the individual collector. As types of pottery become older and rarer and more expensive, perfect pieces become impossible to buy, and collectors must be satisfied with damaged pieces. For example, museums are forced to buy repaired, cracked or damaged specimens. In some cases, such as the old Roman Majolica - only fragments are available which are used in reconstruction.

Personally, as a collector, if there are certain pieces which I want, I am willing to accept some damage provided the piece has a good color and glaze and thus retains its beauty - obviously with some price concession.

Majolica prices have risen substantially in the last ten years, but more important to the collector is the fact that American Majolica is becoming less available. You see less and less at antique dealers, particularly animal figures. Also Clifton is almost unavailable and should be bought whenever available for investment. The Avalon from Baltimore, while not as popular as Etruscan, is rarer and actually much more difficult to collect. It should be bought. Fortunately, the pieces are marked and easy to identify.

The listings keyed to plates and figures in MAJOLICA - COLLECT IT FOR FUN AND PROFIT, Wildey C. Rickerson, are arranged to give plate numbers. Where more than one piece is shown in a plate, the prices start upper left, 1-a, 1-b, 1-c, etc., and the lower row 2-a, 2-b, 2-c. Always from left to right.

Where lists are by design — Etruscan, Shell and Seaweed, Bamboo and Cauliflower — the catalogue again is not complete, but can give a helpful guide to value to both dealers and collectors.

A number of other illustrations are not priced.
